### Blessed Are Those Who Hunger & Thirst After God

*“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,  
for they shall be filled.”*

Have you ever gone to bed hungry? I bet you have, but what kind of hunger was it? Physical, mental, spiritual. All of these hungers can bring us to a place of emptiness and longing. In Darfur region of Sudan women and child sometimes have to walk a mile or greater just to get water or gather firewood to bake bread. According to relief workers in that area many of these women have been raped and several killed while gather wood or fetching water. This is so they can make bread for their hungry children. It was Gandhi who said, “There are so many hungry children in the world for whom the face of God appears as a loaf of bread.” But Africa is not the only place where hunger is so pertinent. Did you know that over 60% of the world will go to bed physically hungry and thirsty.

I remember a time when I was a pastor in Elkton and a single mother called. She had no money left for the month. In humbleness she said, “Could you please help so I can get a bag of potatoes, some bread, cereal and milk.” I heard the little ones in the background. After we got off the phone, I found myself thinking about that mother, about how she was struggling to make ends meet, and wondering about her needs, her hungers, and what it must be like to be in that place. To not have enough to even buy a loaf of bread for my child. I could feel the hunger in my soul for her to have something better, something more than to just struggle for existence for herself and her children; wishing to give her some food to fill her soul. Praying she would hunger for something eternal like the Bread of Life or the living water that will never go dry.

*Jesus says, “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.” Matthew 5:6*

Hunger and thirst are the body’s way of telling us that we are “empty.” Our natural response to physical hunger and thirst is to seek food and water to satisfy our need. But what about the emptiness we feel in our soul? Do we fill it with the things that will satisfy. Each Christian has an inner longing and the only one that can fill that whole in your soul is Christ & Christ’s righteousness. But we cannot be filled with righteousness if we are filled with self or the stuff of this world. It is only God who can satisfy the longing heart and soul. Throughout the Scriptures God emphasizes that the one who longs for Him with all his heart will find Him (Jer. 29:13). As we crave righteousness, a wonderful and strange thing happens in us. We will find ourselves turning to God, repenting of our sin, and God will remove sin from us and replace our selfishness with the fruits of the Spirit: love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23). The Spirit will make us to be like Christ. Righteousness is not to be taken lightly, nor is it easily attained. Holy God does not give His righteousness to people indiscriminately. He gives it to those who earnestly seek after Him. Pursuing righteousness means that we value the opinion of God far more than we treasure the opinions of self and others. Righteousness is not merely an absence of sin. It is allowing God to fill us with His holiness (Rom. 6:11). It is being like Christ. Jesus is our model of One who sought God’s righteousness first, and then the Father glorified Him. We are not only to seek the kingdom of God, but we are also to pursue His righteousness (Matt. 6:33). If we will hunger and thirst for righteousness, we will be satisfied!

Beloved, have you found yourself longing for something more, something more for your family, your church, yourself? Then stop looking to the world for your satisfaction and seek God. Allow Our Lord to fill your soul and make you whole, for *“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.”*

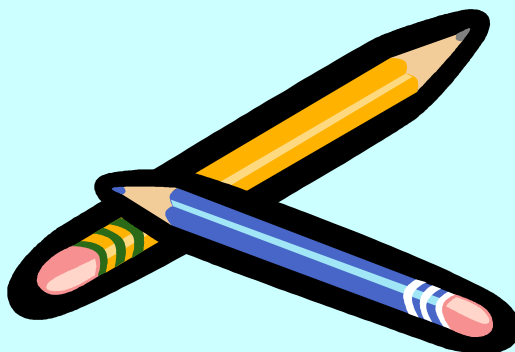
### Chili Cook-off - Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup> - Save the Date!!

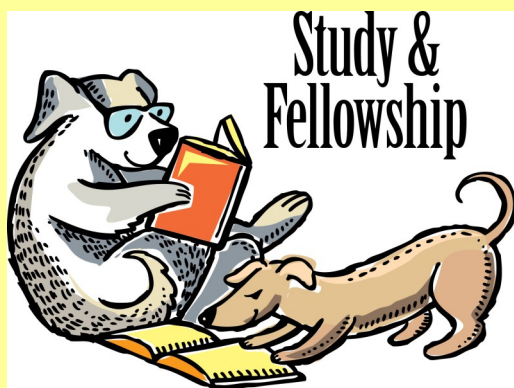
