



World Communion Sunday | October 5th Why We Celebrate It

World Communion Sunday is a celebration observed by several Christian denominations. It offers congregations a distinctive opportunity to experience Holy Communion in the context of the global community of faith.

The first Sunday of October has become a time when Christians in every culture break bread and pour the cup to remember and affirm Christ as the Head of the Church. On that day, they remember that they are part of the whole body of believers.

Whether shared in a grand cathedral, a mud hut, outside on a hilltop, in a meetinghouse, or in a storefront, Christians celebrate the communion liturgy in as many ways as there are congregations. It promotes Christian Unity. World Communion Sunday can be both a profound worship experience and a time for learning more about our wider community of faith.

This year at Foundry, on *Sunday, October 5th*, we are asking the congregation to bring in culturally diverse breads to display on the altar. These breads will then be used for the fellowship social hour following worship service.
